Community Data Roundtable Recognized as Finalist in Pittsburgh's UpPrize Competition: *Receives \$10,000 Award*

In March, CDR was honored to be selected as one of ten social entrepreneurs as a finalist in the *Impactful Technology* category of the 2017 UpPrize Competition. UpPrize, a social innovation challenge created by the Forbes Fund and sponsored by the BNY Mellon Foundation of Southwestern Pennsylvania, is designed to engage the creative thinking of regional innovators to solve some of the community's most pressing problems. The *Impactful Technology* category recognizes products and services that will improve nonprofit service delivery and/or the lives of vulnerable populations in Southwestern PA, and beyond. Community Data Roundtable's submission was focused on the idea of adding a Parent Portal to its already established outcomes tool, the DataPool. This new entryway would allow caregivers to access their child's DataPool information directly, and in a way that is clear and oriented to parental needs.

"We believe the Parent Portal has the ability to greatly improve the experience for parents trying to manage the complex community mental health system. In addition, the portal will prove to be a benefit to the providers and other members of the child's treatment team, because it will assist in engaging the parent."
